Import Antech Lab Results into DVM Manager Patient Files (Applies to DVM for Windows 4.x)

The following procedure can be performed to obtain lab results from www.zoasis.com :

- 1. Navigate to www.zoasis.com. You must have a Zoasis account that has been setup by Antech. Please contact Antech Customer Service team if there are any difficulties logging in.
- 2. First, you will need to log in to the website by entering your **Hospital Account Number** and **ZIP code**.
- 3. The second part of the login is to enter your **username and password**.
- 4. Once logged in, click on **New Lab Results** or **Laboratory** to see the available lab results for download.
- 5. On the right hand side of the screen, put a checkmark in at least one lab result you wish to download.
- 6. From the top drop-down menu, select **Actions -> Import**. You will see another browser window open that displays data for that lab report.
- 7. Click on File -> Save As from within the new browser window which has opened. It is suggested you change the name to something suitable rather than the automatic name of "labreport". Choose a place on your hard drive when you can easily find this file. It will be named with an extension of XML.
- 8. Repeat the process for each individual animal for who you are retrieving lab results.

Import Saved Lab Result files into Patient's History in DVM Manager:

- 9. Launch DVM Manager if it is not already open. It is recommended that you ensure that the correct client is selected and the patient is also highlighted in the Client Tree.
- 10. Go to **File -> Import Zoasis Labs**. There are several options to choose from here, including importing the data to a patient other than the one that is selected. The option we recommend, however, is to **Import for Selected Patient**.
- 11. A window is then displayed from this browse window, navigate to where this XML file was saved, and then click **Open**.
- 12. A message will be displayed indicating the data was imported successfully.
- 13. You may now find the imported exam data on the **Lab/Exam data tab** in that patient's History, or, if using Browser Style History, click on the **Exams** button on the left-hand side to review the imported lab results.
